Our Lord Speaks to Us

EPISTLE READING

Peter reflects on the Transfiguration of Jesus and the declaration of the Father from heaven. What we hear in the Gospels from the evangelists is not a lie, but reality and was seen by many different eyewitnesses. The Scriptures confirm the truth of what has been seen by those eyewitnesses. The Scriptures are the testimony, not just of men, but of God the Holy Spirit. It is the flesh that desires to see "evidence". How have we seen "greater things" than these in connection with the work of the Holy Spirit?

GOSPEL READING

MATTHEW 17: 1-9

2 PETER 1: 12, 16-21

Congregational Welcome: → Glory be to You, O Lord!

The glory of Jesus was revealed to the three disciples in three ways: The radiating brightness of Jesus, the appearance of Moses and Elijah, and the voice of the Father from heaven. Jesus was clearly revealed as the fulfillment of all that was foretold in the Old Testament. He was about to complete that work through His impending suffering and death, pointing them - and us - ahead to the season of Lent. This was something they were not to share this with anyone... yet! When we, by faith, see the transfiguration of Jesus (the Word made flesh), how does this transform our hearts?

Congregational Response: ♪ Praise be to You, O Christ!

I believe in God, the Father almighty, maker of heaven and earth.

I believe in Jesus Christ, His only Son, our Lord, Who was conceived by the Holy Spirit, born of the virgin Mary, suffered under Pontius Pilate, was crucified, died, and was buried. He descended into hell. The third day He rose again from the dead. He ascended into heaven and is seated at the right hand of God the Father almighty. From there He will come to judge the living and the dead.

I believe in the Holy Spirit; the holy Christian Church, the communion of saints; the forgiveness of sins; the resurrection of the body; and the life everlasting. Amen.
