OPPORTUNITY TO SUPPORT CLC MISSION HELPER TRIP

Dear Members of Immanuel Lutheran Church, God has opened a door of opportunity for me to be a part of the CLC Mission Helper Trip this coming summer. The 2019 trip was set for three weeks this summer in India to work with the members of the Church of the Lutheran Confession of India and the Berea Ev. Lutheran Church. However, with growing hostility and persecution towards Christians in that area, the other volunteers and I were faced with a difficult decision as to whether it was now safe for us to travel there. After much prayer and consideration, the CLC Board of Missions has put in motion a new Mission Helper trip to East Africa. I ask that you keep the families of India in your prayers, and that we may be able to send a mission group there in the future.

It is truly a blessing that the Lord has given us a new opportunity to visit the people of Zambia and Tanzania. If the Lord continues to bless our efforts I, along with the other CLC Mission Helper Volunteers, will have the opportunity to proclaim the Gospel to many, many children. Some of these children are already members of our sister congregations, but many of the children we will reach have never truly heard of their Savior Jesus. We will be traveling to different villages where a CLC affiliated congregation is located. In each village we will teach a series of Bible stories that serve to proclaim both the Law and Gospel. These lessons will also include a craft that will reinforce the message. I am very excited to use my God given talents to help spread the word in East Africa!

I am asking for your prayers on behalf of myself, the other volunteers, those with whom I will be working, and the many lost souls who will be reached with the Gospel. As you can well imagine, the financial cost of such service to the Lord is rather large. The cost of the trip is approximately \$3,000 - \$3500. I am also asking for your assistance to help me cover part of the cost for this trip. Any amount you are able to give will be greatly appreciated and put to good use in the Lord's Kingdom. My initial down payment of \$2000 to cover the cost of airfare and other trip expenses will need to be sent in to the Mission Helper Program by March 5. Thank you for your consideration. Please feel free to contact me or the pastors if you have any questions.

UPDATE ON INDIA With the recent cancellation of our Missionary's visa to India and his inability to return, the Board of Missions is reassigning our Resident Missionary to West Africa. He will be based in Togo for the majority of the year and will work with our brethren in Togo, Benin, Ghana, Nigeria and the Democratic Republic of Congo. He will continue to serve as our liaison with our Indian brethren for now. Due to some of the increased scrutiny and problems we and our Indian brethren have had in the last year, the Board of Missions has also made the decision to relocate this year's Mission Helper Trip from India to East Africa. This was done out of concern for the Mission Helpers, but also for our Indian brethren who may be investigated because of the presence of so many foreigners. The Board of Missions is working on a plan to send two CLC pastors to India for a three-week visitation this summer. In addition, our Traveling Missionary plans to make a visit to India later this year. Please remember our Indian brethren in your prayers as they continue to proclaim His truth in a hostile environment!

UPDATE ON OUR VISITING MISSIONARY Missionary Todd Ohlmann has been gone for a month visiting our brethren in Tanzania, Zambia and Myanmar. From there he will be traveling to Nepal where he will spend a week or more. His almost two-month visitation will conclude with a visit to Bangladesh where he and Board of Missions Chairman, Joel Krafft, will meet with a promising contact we have been corresponding with for several years.
