FIRST SCRIPTURE LESSON

ISAIAH 41:16B-20

The process of irrigation has been used since ancient times to get water from where it was, such as rivers, to where it needed to be, such as crop fields. Isaiah speaks of the people of God as being a variety of trees placed in the desert, a location that typically has no water. But God has promised to send His Spirit, the channel, to water our hearts with His Word so that we receive His grace in Jesus name and be spiritually renewed day by day with that Word.

SECOND SCRIPTURE LESSON

ACTS 2:1-13

Congregational Welcome: *Congregational Welcome*: Congregational Welcome

Many people who profess to be Christians believe that the best way for God to gain followers would be for His people to perform miracles. We see in Pentecost that the Spirit's faith-creating power is not in signs and wonders. Even after the sound of a great wind and the tongues of flame, spectators denied the Apostles' message and were quick to reject the Gospel and dismiss them as drunkards. Rather we see that the Spirit creates faith using the Word, and boy is it effective! As we read later in Acts 2, and there were added that day about three thousand souls.

When the Day of Pentecost had fully come, they were all with one accord in one place. **2** And suddenly there came a sound from heaven, as of a rushing mighty wind, and it filled the whole house where they were sitting. **3** Then there appeared to them divided tongues, as of fire, and one sat upon each of them. **4** And they were all filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak with other tongues, as the Spirit gave them utterance. **5** And there were dwelling in Jerusalem Jews, devout men, from every nation under heaven.

6 And when this sound occurred, the multitude came together, and were confused, because everyone heard them speak in his own language. 7 Then they were all amazed and marveled, saying to one another, "Look, are not all these who speak Galileans? 8 "And how is it that we hear, each in our own language in which we were born? and Medes and Elamites, those 9 "Parthians dwelling in Mesopotamia, Judea and Cappadocia, Pontus and Asia, 10 "Phrygia and Pamphylia, Egypt and the parts of Libya adjoining Cyrene, visitors from Rome, both Jews and proselytes, 11 "Cretans and Arabs-- we hear them speaking in our own tongues the wonderful works of God." 12 So they were all amazed and perplexed, saving to one another, "Whatever could this mean?" 13 Others mocking said. "They are full of new wine."

ADJUSTING TO EXPECTATIONS?

Brief recap from our "Marriage Built to Last" class this past week

Are the Expectations of your Marriage realistic?

Our culture today treats marriage like an Olympic High Diver. We are driven to believe that all marriages should either make a perfect splash or they will end with a painful flop.

Whether currently married or not, each one of us has been and will continue to be influenced by what others say a marriage should look like.

What influences your expectations of a Marriage?

- 1. Media. In a 2018 study, American adults spend more than 11 hours per day watching, reading, listening to or simply interacting with media. Think of how the influence of sitcoms, social apps, and sexual propaganda affect a person's mind. How do these influence God's expectations of marriage? Parents worry about "screen time" with children, and yet forget the lost facetime with their spouse. *Psalm 90:12* is a prayer for wisdom in how we spend our time.
- 2. Parents. Growing up, we see a daily model of a marriage. Especially of how a man or woman behaves towards each other in a marriage. This behavior isn't just mirrored in the children but raises the expectations (good or bad) of what a spouse *should* be.

<u>Proverbs 31</u> gives detail about characteristics of a Godly spouse.

3. Friends. Our friends and coworkers know us individually very well. But it doesn't mean they know what's going on within a marriage. Be careful getting advice from a friend, coworker, or family member who doesn't know both sides of why expectations aren't met.

Proverbs 1:5 directs us to seek wise counsel, especially for marriage.

4. Church. Expectations often come by comparisons. Though church is a safe place to receive Godly instruction for a marriage or our day to day life, it is also a place where our sinful flesh is tempted to either pridefully look down on one couple's marriage or feel hopeless in aspiring to be like another couple's marriage.

<u>Ephesians 5</u> uses a picture of Christ and the Church to show His expectations for a marriage that prioritizes God, spouse, you.

Is one's expectations within a marriage realistic? There will always be all kinds of physical and emotional adjustments throughout the life of a marriage. But *how* a couple handles these expectations and adjustments together gives opportunity to demonstrate Christ-like understanding, patience, and a love that is committed to growing together in Christ!
