## OUR LORD SPEAKS TO US

#### **OLD TESTAMENT READING**

DANIEL 2:31-39

Daniel interprets this strange dream of King Nebuchadnezzar while enslaved in Babylon. God gives the king the future of the political world. In this vision, we see pictures of the ruling forces which would dominate the world for years to come. But it also points to the truth that God is in

control no matter what is happening, and continues to work all things for His good.

"You, O king, were watching; and behold, a great image! This great image, whose splendor was excellent, stood before you; and its form was awesome. 32 This image's head was of fine gold, its chest and arms of silver, its belly and thighs of bronze, 33 its legs of iron, its feet partly of iron and partly of clay. 34 You watched while a stone was cut out without hands, which struck the image on its feet of iron and clay, and broke them in pieces. 35 Then the iron, the clay, the bronze, the silver, and the gold were crushed together, and became like chaff from the summer threshing floors; the wind carried them away so that no trace of them was found. And the stone that struck the image became a great mountain and filled the 36 "This is the dream. Now we will tell the whole earth. interpretation of it before the king. 37 You, O king, are a king of kings. For the God of heaven has given you a kingdom, power, strength, and glory; 38 and wherever the children of men dwell, or the beasts of the field and the birds of the heaven. He has given them into your hand, and has made you ruler over them all—you are this head of gold. 39 But after you shall arise another kingdom inferior to yours; then another, a third kingdom of bronze, which shall rule over all the earth.

#### **GOSPEL READING**

LUKE 17:1-10

We live in a sinful world, so we should expect temptation. However, God has a stern warning for anyone who would lead His children astray and away from the truth of His Word. The disciples recognize the great amount of faith it would take to forgive someone seven times for the same sin in the same day, so they ask for more faith. Jesus goes on to remind them and us that forgiving others is not an act of service on our part, but rather our Christian calling, just as God has forgiven us.

Jesus Warns of Offenses

Then He said to the disciples, "It is impossible that no offenses should come, but woe to him through whom they do come! 2 It would be better for him if a millstone were hung around his neck, and he were thrown into the sea, than that he should offend one of these little ones. 3 Take heed to yourselves. If your brother sins against you, rebuke him; and if he repents, forgive him. 4 And if he

sins against you seven times in a day, and seven times in a day returns to you, saying, 'I repent,' you shall forgive him."

5 And the apostles said to the Lord, "Increase our faith." 6 So the Lord said, "If you have faith as a mustard seed, you can say to this mulberry tree, 'Be pulled up by the roots and be planted in the sea,' and it would obey you. 7 And which of you, having a servant plowing or tending sheep, will say to him when he has come in from the field, 'Come at once and sit down to eat'? 8 But will he not rather say to him, 'Prepare something for my supper, and gird yourself and serve me till I have eaten and drunk, and afterward you will eat and drink'? 9 Does he thank that servant because he did the things that were commanded him? I think not. 10 So likewise you, when you have done all those things which you are commanded, say, 'We are unprofitable servants. We have done what was our duty to do.' "

# SEX AND INTIMACY?

Brief recap from our "Marriage Built to Last" class this past week

#### First things first...

Remember some critical Words from our Lord God:

"Marriage should be honored by all, and the marriage bed kept pure, for God will judge the adulterer and all the sexually immoral." (Heb 13:4)

God gave Sex as a gift. He doesn't want us to spoil it. That's why He wants His gift kept pure... whether married or unmarried.

"Now to the unmarried and the widows I say: It is good for them to stay unmarried, as I am. But if they cannot control themselves, they should marry, for it is better to marry than to burn with passion." (1 Cor 7:8-9)

What does our Lord say to encourage the believer?

"Flee from sexual immorality. All other sins a man commits are outside his body, but he who sins sexually sins against his own body. Do you not know that your body is a temple of the Holy Spirit, who is in you, whom you have received from God? You are not your own; you were bought at a price. Therefore honor God with your body." (1 Cor 6:18-20)

#### How can Sex and Intimacy be restored in a Marriage?

Sexual interaction is an important part of marriage, but we shouldn't isolate it from the rest of the relationship. That physical experience is connected to everything else you do together-emotionally, spiritually, practically.

#### Ask: What can I do to demonstrate my commitment to you?

Consider spending more time together at home, compliments, praying together, move involvement with the kids, etc. Sometimes the best way to show unconditional love is to do something you don't prefer doing in order to please the other.

- **2.** What time can we put in our schedule on a weekly basis for significant communication? Consider reserving a regular weekly time for this time... breakfast? A call from work? After dinner? After kids are in bed? Before bed? You don't need to have major conferences each day, but it's helpful to identify those times that can become precious to your marriage.
- 3. List three activities you like to do with your spouse.

Don't just list them mentally here, communicate them. Now, try to find a weekly "activity time" to do some of these things with them. Maintaining that friendship can lead to further types of intimacy. If once a week doesn't work, make sure once a month happens.

**4.** What ministries are you currently involved in, individually and as a couple? You are already serving Christ together by prayerfully putting Christ first in your marriage. Now you have the opportunity to display Christ's leadership through you not just in your prayers but using your God-given talents to serve whether at home or in church. This type of sacrificial, self-less work can really promote that type of self-less attitude also within your marriage.

Our congregation has recently formed an Elders team that is looking for volunteers to reach out to those we haven't seen for a while, help the elderly or hospitalized, or give and send encouragements to our members and friends at a distance whether they are in college, the military, or living further away from our congregation. Just ask!
