

INVOCATION We invoke ("call upon") the name of our Triune God.

Pastor (P): In the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit.

Congregation (C): Amen.

OUR CONFESSION OF SINS

P: Beloved in the Lord! Let us draw near with a true heart and confess our sins unto God, our Father, beseeching Him in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ to grant us forgiveness. Our help is in the name of the Lord.

C: Nho made heaven and earth.

P: I said, I will confess my transgressions unto the Lord.

C: ^ And You forgave the iniquity of my sin.

P: Almighty God, our Maker and Redeemer, we poor sinners confess unto You that we are by nature sinful and unclean and that we have sinned against You by thought, word, and deed. Therefore we flee for refuge to Your infinite mercy, seeking and imploring Your grace for the sake of our Lord Jesus Christ.

C: O most merciful God, who has given Your only-begotten Son to die for us, have mercy upon us and for His sake grant us remission of all our sins; and by Your Holy Spirit increase in us true knowledge of You and of Your will and true obedience to Your Word, to the end that by Your grace we may come to everlasting life; through Jesus Christ, our Lord. Amen.

P: Almighty God, our Heavenly Father, has had mercy upon us and has given His only Son to die for us, and for His sake forgives us all our sins. To all who believe on His name He gives the privilege of being children of God and has promised them His Holy Spirit. He that believes and is baptized shall be saved. Grant this, Lord, unto us all. C: Amen.

1ST READING (RESPONSIVELY) 1 CHRONICLES 16: 7-36

Why do we worship the LORD? Why do we gather together with fellow believers to sing the LORD's praise, give Him glory, bring our offerings, and proclaim His salvation? Because He is worthy of our praise, glory offerings, and proclamation! When we think of all that God has done, not just in our individual lives but throughout the history of the world for our salvation, we should be moved to do all of that, and much more!

P: On that day David first delivered this psalm into the hand of Asaph and his brethren, to thank the LORD:

Oh, give thanks to the LORD! Call upon His name;

C: Make known His deeds among the peoples!

P: Sing to Him, sing psalms to Him; Talk of all His wondrous works!

C: Glory in His holy name; Let the hearts of those rejoice who seek the LORD!

P: Seek the LORD and His strength;

C: Seek His face evermore!

P: Remember His marvelous works which He has done, His wonders, and the judgments of His mouth, O seed of Israel His servant, You children of Jacob, His chosen ones!

C: He is the LORD our God; His judgments are in all the earth.

P: Remember His covenant forever, The word which He commanded, for a thousand generations, The covenant which He made with Abraham, And His oath to Isaac, And confirmed it to Jacob for a statute, To Israel for an everlasting covenant, Saying,

C: "To you I will give the land of Canaan As the allotment of your inheritance," When you were few in number, Indeed very few, and strangers in it.

P: When they went from one nation to another, And from one kingdom to another people, He permitted no man to do them wrong; Yes, He rebuked kings for their sakes, Saying,

C: "Do not touch My anointed ones, And do My prophets no harm." P: Sing to the LORD, all the earth; Proclaim the good news of His salvation from day to day.

C: Declare His glory among the nations, His wonders among all peoples.

P: For the LORD is great and greatly to be praised; He is also to be feared above all gods. For all the gods of the peoples are idols, But the LORD made the heavens.

C: Honor and majesty are before Him; Strength and gladness are in His place.

P: Give to the LORD, O families of the peoples, Give to the LORD glory and strength.

C: Give to the LORD the glory due His name; Bring an offering, and come before Him. Oh, worship the LORD in the beauty of holiness!

P: Tremble before Him, all the earth. The world also is firmly established, It shall not be moved. Let the heavens rejoice, and let the earth be glad; And let them say among the nations,

C: "The LORD reigns." Let the sea roar, and all its fullness; Let the field rejoice, and all that is in it.

P: Then the trees of the woods shall rejoice before the LORD, For He is coming to judge the earth. Oh, give thanks to the LORD, for He is good!

C: For His mercy endures forever.

P: And say, "Save us, O God of our salvation; Gather us together, and deliver us from the Gentiles, To give thanks to Your holy name, To triumph in Your praise."

C: Blessed be the LORD God of Israel From everlasting to everlasting!

P: And all the people said,

C: "Amen!"

2ND READING COLOSSIANS 3:12-17

Congregational Welcome: _ Glory be to You, O Lord!

In this section of Colossians, Paul describes the Christian life. As Christians we are to show kindness, forgiveness, and love, in our interactions with all people, but especially our fellow believers. But in the middle of this section on the Christian life, Paul points to the importance of worship. Worship connects us to God and His word, and it connects us with our fellow believers. Worship is not intended to be only personal, but relational and corporate. And how important that is!

Therefore, as the elect of God, holy and beloved, put on tender mercies, kindness, humility, meekness, longsuffering; 13 bearing with one another, and forgiving one another, if anyone has a complaint against another; even as Christ forgave you, so you also must do.

14 But above all these things put on love, which is the bond of perfection. 15 And let the peace of God rule in your hearts, to which also you were called in one body; and be thankful. 16 Let the word of Christ dwell in you richly in all wisdom, teaching and admonishing one another in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing with grace in your hearts to the Lord. 17 And whatever you do in word or deed, do all in the name of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks to God the Father through Him.

Holy Baptism True Doctrine

A Sacrament is a sacred act: not what we do for God, but what He does for us! Baptism means "to wash"

Meaning: Christ and His Apostles point to Baptism as a means of entering the kingdom of God (Romans 6:3-4). Baptism is a spiritual rebirth by the Holy Spirit through water and the Word. Baptism washes away sin and saves. Through baptism God forgives all sin (both original sin and actual sin). John 3:5-6, Titus 3:5, Acts 2:38, 22:16; 1 Peter 3:21.

Application: The Bible doesn't specify how the water should be applied in Baptism. The word "baptize" in the original Greek language simply means "to wash" (Acts 22:16).

Infant Baptism: It is God's will that infants be baptized. (Acts 2:38-39) We baptize infants because 1) infants too are a part of "all nations" (Matthew 28:19-20), 2) infants too are sinful from conception (Psalm 51:15), and 3) infants too can believe (Luke 18:15-17).

Adult Baptism: (accepting Christ) - No one can say that Jesus is Lord, except by the Holy Spirit (1 Corinthians 12:3). God creates faith in our hearts apart from any work or acceptance of Him on our own (Titus 3:4-7). Like the earth receiving a seed in the ground (1 Corinthians 3:6).

Triune God: Only baptisms administered in the name of the Triune God are valid. Matthew 28:19.

Holy Baptism False Doctrine

- Baptism symbolizes the forgiveness of sins and salvation. [REF]
- Baptism only forgives original sin and the sins we commit before our baptism. [RC]
- All baptisms, to be valid, must be performed by immersion.
 [BAP]
- Baptism is a dedication of person to God (whether a child or adult). It has no power to bring people into God's family. Only those who have reached the age of discretion should be baptized. [BAP, REF]
- Baptisms are administered in the name of a god that is not Triune. [LDS]
