MINI DEVOTIONAL The evangelist John records a long discourse Jesus had with his disciples on the night He was betrayed (John 13:31-16:33). He knew His death was imminent, and was preparing His disciples. Previously, He had told them He would be killed and after three days rise again. However, "... they understood none of these things; this saying was hidden from them, and they did not know the things which were spoken." (Luke 18:34)

Picture the disciples gathered together after His death and burial, on the day following the Sabbath. They are mourning, and greatly afraid of what will happen to them. Jesus had said in that last lengthy address, "A little while longer and the world will see Me no more, but you will see Me. Because I live, you will live also. At that day you will know that I am in My Father, and you in Me, and I in you." How empty those words must have seemed! He was dead! Would they soon be hunted down and likewise executed?

But suddenly, there He was in the midst of them! They see that He is alive! Not temporarily, but eternally! Now those words, "Because I live, you will live also" have the most profound meaning. They too, and we also, will live eternally. They could face the enemies of Jesus with complete confidence, and so can we. – Paul Bade
