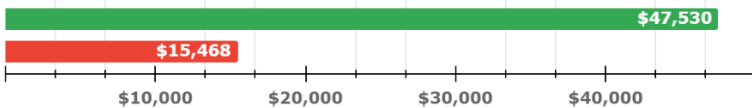

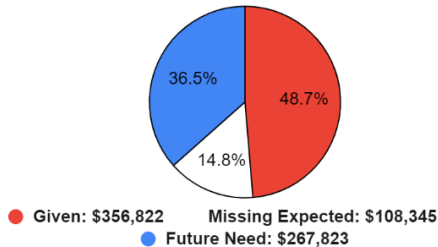
Immanuel Budget/Offerings: \$732,990 (Jan-Dec)

**VOLUNTEER NEEDED** The Board of Finance is looking for a volunteer bookkeeper. This is a subset of the work of the Treasurer and would work with and report to the Treasurer. The bookkeeper will:

- Weekly pay bills and track expenses in Shepherd's Staff. Most recurring bills are on automatic payments. Others are collected from the mail, scanned, and emailed by the church secretary. (1-1.5 hours a week) - This can be done from home.
- Twice a month (between the 1st-4th and 16th-18th) do payroll. Payroll is handled through MinistryWorks (which handles taxes, social security, and direct deposit). Payroll occurs on the 7th and 22nd or prior banking day if 7th or 22nd falls on a non-banking day, and needs to be to MinistryWorks 3 business days beforehand. (1-2 hours twice a month)
  - For hourly employees the plan is to streamline the current process by having the secretaries handle adjusting/fixing punch card entries in MinistryWorks.
- Monthly (prior to council meeting (second Tuesday of the Month) reconcile the previous month's books and aid the Treasurer in generating reports. (4 hours a month).

Since this position is managed by the Treasurer there are no constitution requirements for this position. At this time, we are seeking a member to volunteer. Absent a volunteer, we may consider hiring someone internal or external.
