OUR LORD SPEAKS TO US

1ST READING EXODUS 40:34-38

When the Children of Israel finished building the tabernacle according to God's directions, the LORD's presence filled the tabernacle. His glory filled the tabernacle because He was present in it. In a similar way, our Savior is present with us when we celebrate the Lord's Supper. He is bodily present in, with and under the forms of bread and wine. We ought to have a healthy respect for the presence of the LORD when we come to worship and when we celebrate the Lord's Supper. Jesus is here!

Then the cloud covered the tabernacle of meeting, and the glory of the LORD filled the tabernacle. **35** And Moses was not able to enter the tabernacle of meeting, because the cloud rested above it, and the glory of the LORD filled the tabernacle. **36** Whenever the cloud was taken up from above the tabernacle, the children of Israel would go onward in all their journeys. **37** But if the cloud was not taken up, then they did not journey till the day that it was taken up. **38** For the cloud of the LORD was above the tabernacle by day, and fire was over it by night, in the sight of all the house of Israel, throughout all their journeys.

RESPONSIVE READING PSALM 114

This Psalm reminds us of several important Biblical truths that we need to keep in mind when we reflect on the Lord's Supper. First, God is all powerful. God can do anything that He says He will do. Second, it is not about us, but about Him and what He alone is able to do for sinners. The Lord's Supper is not about our work or action but is about the work and action of the only True God for sinners. We only need to trust in the clear words and promises God makes to us!

2ND READING LUKE 22:14-22

Jesus institutes the Lord's Supper on Maundy Thursday night, as He was celebrating the Passover with His disciples. He uses two items which were part of the Passover meal, to institute a new celebration meal for the future. Jesus says that when Christians properly celebrate this new Supper, they receive His very body with unleavened bread, and they receive His very blood with the wine in the cup. That's why it is called, "The Lord's Supper."

When the hour had come, He sat down, and the twelve apostles with Him. **15** Then He said to them, "With fervent desire I have desired to eat this Passover with you before I suffer; **16** "for I say to you, I will no longer eat of it until it is fulfilled in the kingdom of God." **17** Then He took the cup, and gave thanks, and said, "Take this and divide it among yourselves; **18** "for I say to you, I will not drink of the fruit of the vine until the kingdom of God comes." **19** And He took bread, gave thanks and broke it, and gave it to them, saying, "This is My body which is given for you; do this in remembrance of Me." **20** Likewise He also took the cup after supper, saying, "This cup is the new covenant in My blood, which is shed for you. **21** "But behold, the hand of My betrayer is with Me on the table. **22** "And truly the Son of Man goes as it has been determined, but woe to that man by whom He is betrayed!"

<p>A Holy Sacrament - Holy Communion is correctly called a 'Sacrament' because it is a "Sacred act;" not in what WE do for Christ, but in what Christ does for US.</p> <p>Spiritual Unity - God's Word also presents the reception of this Sacrament as a most intimate expression of spiritual and confessional unity (1 Cor. 1:10; 10:16-17; Rom. 15:5,6).</p> <p>Close Communion - We ask only those who have publicly professed such oneness of faith and belief with us by membership here or another CLC church to come forward for Communion at this time. This is not a judgment of anyone's faith, but rather an expression of ours (1 Cor. 1:10; 10:16-17; Rom. 16:17-18).</p> <p>Visitors - If there are visitors present who wish to commune with us in the future, you are invited to speak with the Pastor about this at your convenience. We'd love to have you!</p>	<p>Kneeling rail - Members who have difficulty at the kneeling rail may sit in the front pew on either side. The pastors will bring communion to you there.</p> <p>Balcony - Any communicants sitting in the balcony should please come down to the narthex for direction to the table.</p> <p>Direction - Communicants are ushered to the communion table. If you desire the bread in your hand, simply extend your hand to the Pastor as he approaches you with the bread. Those desiring an individual cup, please take a cup when the tray is offered. The common cup will follow.</p> <p>Gluten Free / Non-alcoholic grape wine - Communicants can find these items on the way up to the Lord's Table.</p> <p>Dispose cup - Please dispose of your individual cup in the baskets located on each side or in the center aisle.</p>

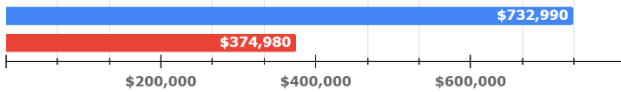

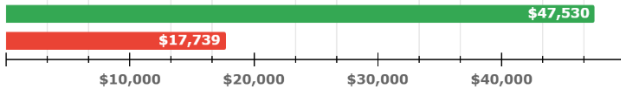

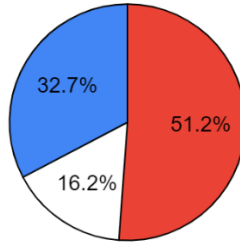
Immanuel Budget/Offerings: \$732,990 (Jan-Dec)
