# The Christmas Account (NASB)

Luke 2

Luke 2:1-7 Now it came about in those days that a decree went out from Caesar Augustus, that a census be taken of all the inhabited earth. <sup>2</sup> This was the first census taken while Quirinius was governor of Syria. <sup>3</sup> And all were proceeding to register for the census, everyone to his own city. <sup>4</sup> And Joseph also went up from Galilee, from the city of Nazareth, to Judea, to the city of David, which is called Bethlehem, because he was of the house and family of David, <sup>5</sup> in order to register, along with Mary, who was engaged to him, and was with child. <sup>6</sup> And it came about that while they were there, the days were completed for her to give birth. <sup>7</sup> And she gave birth to her first-born son; and she wrapped Him in cloths, and laid Him in a manger, because there was no room for them in the inn.

TLH 84:1

Christians, awake, salute the happy morn, Whereon the Savior of the world was born. Rise to adore the mystery of love, Which hosts of angels chanted from above; With them the joyful tidings first begun, Of God Incarnate and the Virgin's Son!

Luke 2:8-12 And in the same region there were some shepherds staying out in the fields, and keeping watch over their flock by night. <sup>9</sup> And an angel of the Lord suddenly stood before them, and the glory of the Lord shone around them; and they were terribly frightened. <sup>10</sup> And the angel said to them, "Do not be

afraid; for behold, I bring you good news of a great joy which shall be for all the people; <sup>11</sup> for today in the city of David there has been born for you a Savior, who is Christ the Lord. <sup>12</sup> "And this will be a sign for you: you will find a baby wrapped in cloths, and lying in a manger."

TLH 84:2

Then to the watchful shepherds it was told, Who heard the angelic herald's voice, "Behold, I bring good tidings of a Savior's birth, To you and all the nations upon earth; This day hath God fulfilled His promised word; This day is born a Savior, Christ the Lord!"

Luke 2:13-14 And suddenly there appeared with the angel a multitude of the heavenly host praising God, and saying, "Glory to God in the highest, And on earth peace among men with whom He is pleased."

TLH 84:3

He spake; and straightway the celestial choir, In hymns of joy, unknown before, conspire; The praises of redeeming love they sang, And heaven's whole orb with alleluias rang. God's highest glory was their anthem still, Peace upon earth, and unto men good will!

Luke 2:15-18 And it came about when the angels had gone away from them into heaven, that the shepherds began saying to one another, "Let us go straight to Bethlehem then, and see this thing that has happened which the Lord has made known to us." <sup>16</sup> And they came in haste and found their way to Mary and Joseph, and the baby as He lay in the manger. <sup>17</sup> And when they had seen this, they made known the statement which had been told them about

this Child. <sup>18</sup> And all who heard it wondered at the things which were told them by the shepherds.

TLH 84:4

To Bethlehem straight th' enlightened shepherds ran,
To see the wonder God had wrought for man,
And found, with Joseph and the blessed maid,
Her Son, the Savior, in a manger laid;
Then to their flocks, still praising God, return.
And their glad hearts with holy rapture burn.

Luke 2:19-20 But Mary treasured up all these things, pondering them in her heart. <sup>20</sup> And the shepherds went back, glorifying and praising God for all that they had heard and seen, just as had been told them.

TLH 84:5

Oh, may we keep and ponder in our mind, God's wondrous love in saving lost mankind! Trace we the Babe, who hath retrieved our loss, From His poor manger to His bitter cross, Tread in His steps, assisted by His grace, Till man's first heavenly state again takes place.

### Scripture Lesson

Hebrews 1:1-12

In the past God spoke to our forefathers through the prophets at many times and in various ways, <sup>2</sup> but in these last days he has spoken to us by his Son, whom he appointed heir of all things, and through whom he made the universe. <sup>3</sup> The Son is the radiance of God's glory and the exact representation of his being, sustaining all things by his powerful word. After he had provided purification for sins, he sat down at the right hand of the Majesty in heaven. <sup>4</sup> So he became as much superior to the angels as the name he has inherited is superior to theirs. <sup>5</sup> For to which of the angels did God ever say, "You are my Son; today I have become your Father"? Or again, "I will be his Father, and he will be my

Son"?  $^6$  And again, when God brings his firstborn into the world, he says, "Let all God's angels worship him."

TLH 84:6

Then may we hope, th' angelic hosts among, To sing, redeemed, a glad triumphal song. He that was born upon this joyful day Around us all His glory shall display. Saved by His love, incessant we shall sing, Eternal praise to heaven's almighty King!

<sup>7</sup> In speaking of the angels he says, "He makes his angels winds, his servants flames of fire." <sup>8</sup> But about the Son he says, "Your throne, O God, will last for ever and ever, and righteousness will be the scepter of your kingdom. <sup>9</sup> You have loved righteousness and hated wickedness; therefore God, your God, has set you above your companions by anointing you with the oil of joy." <sup>10</sup> And: "You, LORD, in the beginning laid the foundation of the earth, And the heavens are the work of Your hands. <sup>11</sup> They will perish, but You remain; And they will all grow old like a garment; <sup>12</sup> Like a cloak You will fold them up, And they will be changed. But You are the same, And Your years will not fail."
