General Fund – February receipts: **\$69,641 VS** disbursements: **\$80,141**. The General Fund subsidizes the work of the Boards of Missions, Trustees, EdPub, & Regents (including ILC.)

ILC Operations – February receipts: \$164,264 VS disbursements: \$126,813.

IIF – February receipts: \$2,858 VS disbursements: None.

ILC Building Projects – February receipts: **\$9,405** (including a \$5,076 increase in market value of investments) **VS** disbursements: **None**.

MDF - February receipts: \$11,604 VS disbursements: \$10,678.

Kinship – February receipts: \$29,175 VS disbursements: \$2,448.

CEF – February receipts: \$34,642 (including a \$14,391 increase in market value of investments) **VS** disbursements: \$79,913 (mostly payments on member loans to the CEF).

SAF – February receipts: **\$6,098 VS** disbursements: **\$10,510** (including student loans, grants, scholarships and tuition assistance).

Reserve Fund is currently invested in a money market account until needed, typically each fiscal year-end.

EduK8 Fund – February receipts: \$5,916. Balance \$43,025.
