

Sermon

John 8:12-20

Then Jesus spoke to them again, saying, "I am the light of the world. He who follows Me shall not walk in darkness, but have the light of life." 13 The Pharisees therefore said to Him, "You bear witness of Yourself; Your witness is not true." 14 Jesus answered and said to them, "Even if I bear witness of Myself, My witness is true, for I know where I came from and where I am going; but you do not know where I come from and where I am going. 15 "You judge according to the flesh; I judge no one. 16 "And yet if I do judge, My judgment is true; for I am not alone, but I am with the Father who sent Me. 17 "It is also written in your law that the testimony of two men is true. 18 "I am One who bears witness of Myself, and the Father who sent Me bears witness of Me." 19 Then they said to Him, "Where is Your Father?" QUARTERLY VOTERS' MEETING April 22, 2024

In membership matters, accepted by confession of faith were: Josh and Rebecca Wakefield with baptized daughter Norah; Linnea Saleg with baptized son Chet Bresser; Bailey and Josie Reichel with baptized daughter Eleanor; and Lisa Carroll. Transferred from Grace of Sleepy Eye, MN (effective 5/25) Pastor Nathanael and Debra Mayhew with communicant children Daniel, Julia and Mark and baptized son Noah. Released per their requests Megan (Westermayer) Dehmer; and Ross and Jacquelyn Libby with children Chauncey, Fin and Grayson.

The Treasurer's Report showed we received \$158,798 in general plate offering which is 84% of our budgeted amount of \$188,414. Total income was \$198,135 which is 86% of the \$229,458 budget. Tuition was \$38,936 which is 95% of the \$40,784 budget. Expenses were \$229,393 which is 95% of the \$241.883 budget.

The Financial Secretary reported that \$75,000 of our General Saving Account will be invested in 5-month CDs.

The Board of Deacons reported that Pastor Mayhew will be installed on May 25 at 4pm. His salary will start on June 1. He has a planned vacation at the beginning of June. The Elder team has met to call uninvolved members. The outreach committee is planning a number of events (movie night, ice cream social, parades in St. Peter and North Mankato, Night to Unite). There is a group of members in Brainerd that are regularly meeting together.

The Board of Property reported that the new phone system was installed, and most of the interior lights were replaced with LEDs.

The Board of Education reported that Debra Mayhew was called for music and Holly Harris and Deedra Macias have received renewed calls for 2024-2025. We will not be participating in the Minnesota State High School League for Basketball in 2024-2025. The new history curriculum was approved. The board is working on a Mission and Purpose statement for the school.

The Cemetery Board reported that they signed a mowing contract with a new person this year.

The Prairie Ad Hoc Committee reported that they have a mission statement, and are looking at the current zoning.

The Committee of the Congregation reported that they have not been meeting while we have only one pastor. Prior to pausing they had frozen the list of questions they will consider and will now work on passages and application.

Up to 27 round tables with racks were accepted.

The 2020 Sanctuary Improvement project was marked complete and the remaining funds transferred to the Major Improvement Fund.

The meeting was adjourned.
