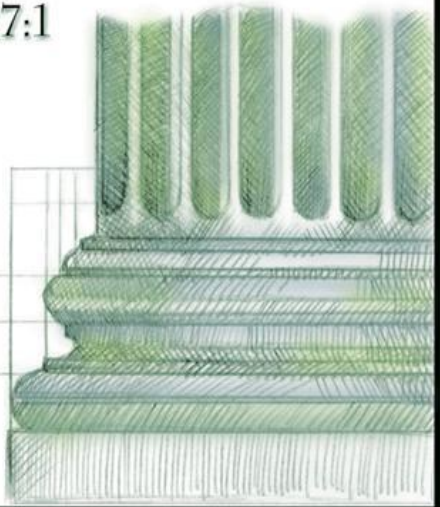
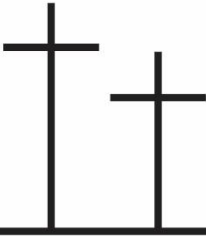

*Deuteronomy 6:4-15*
