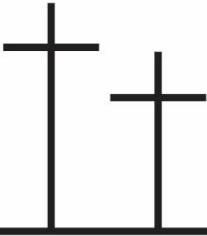

## **Children's Sermon**

*Building Relationships*

**Sermon***Joshua 24:14-28*

"Now therefore, fear the LORD, serve Him in sincerity and in truth, and put away the gods which your fathers served on the other side of the River and in Egypt. Serve the LORD! **15** And if it seems evil to you to serve the LORD, choose for yourselves this day whom you will serve, whether the gods which your fathers served that were on the other side of the River, or the gods of the Amorites, in whose land you dwell. But as for me and my house, we will serve the LORD." **16** So the people answered and said: "Far be it from us that we should forsake the LORD to serve other gods; **17** for the LORD our God is He who brought us and our fathers up out of the land of Egypt, from the house of bondage, who did those great signs in our sight, and preserved us in all the way that we went and among all the people through whom we passed. **18** And the LORD drove out from before us all the people, including the Amorites who dwelt in the land. We also will serve the LORD, for He is our God." **19** But Joshua said to the people, "You cannot serve the LORD, for He is a holy God. He is a jealous God; He will not forgive your transgressions nor your sins. **20** If you forsake the LORD and serve foreign gods, then He will turn and do you harm and consume you, after He has done you good." **21** And the people said to Joshua, "No, but we will serve the LORD!" **22** So Joshua said to the people, "You are witnesses against yourselves that you have chosen the LORD for yourselves, to serve Him." And they said, "We are witnesses!" **23** "Now therefore," he said, "put away the foreign gods which are among you, and incline your heart to the LORD God of Israel." **24** And the people said to Joshua, "The LORD our God we will serve, and His voice we will obey!" **25** So Joshua made a covenant with the people that day, and made for them a statute and an ordinance in Shechem. **26** Then Joshua wrote these words in the Book of the Law of God. And he took a large stone, and set it up there under the oak that was by the sanctuary

of the LORD. **27** And Joshua said to all the people, “Behold, this stone shall be a witness to us, for it has heard all the words of the LORD which He spoke to us. It shall therefore be a witness to you, lest you deny your God.” **28** So Joshua let the people depart, each to his own inheritance.

**THE LORD'S SUPPER NEXT WEEKEND** Next weekend we will be celebrating the Lord's Supper in our worship service. The Lord's Supper is a wonderful gift the Lord has given to His church. Through it, as the Bible says, we receive Jesus' true body and blood for the forgiveness of sin. But because it is so precious and powerful, the Lord has also commanded us to handle it with great care. ***"Therefore, whoever eats the bread or drinks the cup of the Lord in an unworthy manner will be guilty of sinning against the body and blood of the Lord. A man ought to examine himself before he eats of the bread and drinks of the cup. For anyone who eats and drinks without recognizing the body of the Lord eats and drinks judgment on himself"*** (1 Corinthians 11:27-29).

The Bible also teaches that when people commune together they are publicly showing that they hold a common belief in all of the Bible's teachings. The Apostle Paul declares: ***"Because there is one loaf, we, who are many are one body, for we all partake of the one loaf"*** (1 Corinthians 10:17). Thus, reception of the Lord's Supper is a public announcement that you stand in total agreement with the doctrine and practice of your congregation and church body and are united with them in faith and fellowship.

For these reasons, it is very important to us who communes with us. Therefore, if you are a visitor to our church, but would like to commune with us in the future, we ask that you speak with one of our pastors to discuss this matter. We follow this practice in obedience to the Word of God, and not in judgment of anyone's Christian faith, sincerity, or standing before God. We thank you for your cooperation in this important matter.

**PREPARATION FOR THE LORD'S SUPPER** The apostle Paul reminds us of the importance of personal preparation for the Lord's Supper saying: ***"Let a man examine himself, and so let him eat of the bread and drink of the cup"*** (1 Corinthians 11:28). As an aid to communicants in such examination in preparation for next weekend, we suggest the use of Psalm 38 or another Psalm of Repentance. Please sign our Communion Register in the Church Narthex or in the Church Office Entrance if you plan to receive the Lord's Supper next weekend.

May the LORD strengthen and comfort each of our communicants through the reception of this Sacrament next weekend!
