### **Epistle Reading**

*Romans 10:1-15*

Brethren, my heart's desire and prayer to God for Israel is that they may be saved. **2** For I bear them witness that they have a zeal for God, but not according to knowledge. **3** For they being ignorant of God's righteousness, and seeking to establish their own righteousness, have not submitted to the righteousness of God. **4** For Christ is the end of the law for righteousness to everyone who believes. **5** For Moses writes about the righteousness which is of the law, “The man who

does those things shall live by them.” **6** But the righteousness of faith speaks in this way, “Do not say in your heart, ‘Who will ascend into heaven?’” (that is, to bring Christ down from above) **7** or, “‘Who will descend into the abyss?’” (that is, to bring Christ up from the dead). **8** But what does it say? “The word is near you, in your mouth and in your heart” (that is, the word of faith which we preach): **9** that if you confess with your mouth the Lord Jesus and believe in your heart that God has raised Him from the dead, you will be saved. **10** For with the heart one believes unto righteousness, and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation. **11** For the Scripture says, “Whoever believes on Him will not be put to shame.” **12** For there is no distinction between Jew and Greek, for the same Lord over all is rich to all who call upon Him. **13** For “whoever calls on the name of the LORD shall be saved.” **14** How then shall they call on Him in whom they have not believed? And how shall they believe in Him of whom they have not heard? And how shall they hear without a preacher? **15** And how shall they preach unless they are sent? As it is written: “How beautiful are the feet of those who preach the gospel of peace, Who bring glad tidings of good things!”

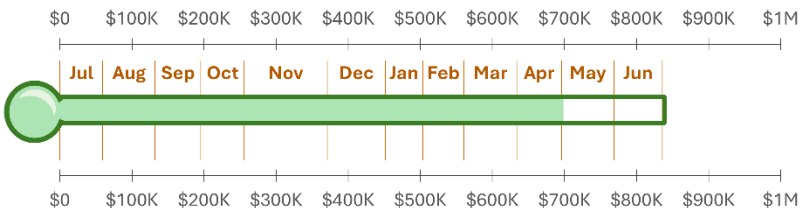

**CLC MISSION PRAYERS** Democratic Republic of the Congo (Central Africa) – Missionaries Peter Evensen and Todd Ohlmann recently concluded a visit to our brothers and sisters in Christ in Kinshasa and the Lubumbashi areas of the DRC. They had the privilege of conducting Bible Training Seminars in both locations. They were also on hand for the graduation and ordination of three seminary graduate of the CCL-Congo (CCLC) in Lubumbashi. Two of them will serve a newly established and growing congregation on the outskirts of Lubumbashi. The congregation in Kinshasa has had to move locations a few times over the past few years since losing their worship facility. ... Pray that the Lord will provide the resources to purchase land and build a permanent church. The seminary of the CCLC has been meeting in a temporary location for months due to security concerns due to militia and DRC military clashes in the area. ... Pray for peace and stability so that the training of men for the ministry may resume at the seminary. ... Thank the Lord for providing three new faithful preachers and teachers of God's saving word for the CCLC and ask Him to bless them and those they are called to serve.
